ВПР проводятся на региональном или школьном уровне по заданиям, разработанным федеральными экспертами, что обеспечивает единство подходов к составлению вариантов заданий, проведению и оцениванию работ. Результаты ВПР заносятся в федеральную информационную систему для дальнейшего анализа.


